Wright Township is looking for Election Inspectors. At this time, we are in need of a Republican Inspector for the November 04, 2025 Election. But for 2026 Elections, many more are needed because of the Early Voting that is now for all State and Federal Elections. If this is something that does not interest you, I have listed below what age a person must be to work as an Election Inspector. Possibly you have a son, daughter, or grandchild, who may want to learn about community participation. In the past I know some students have used this for extra credit, or to gain some extra cash. It is a 15-hour day, but they could make up to \$200.00. And there is always a seasoned Inspector to work with you.

To serve as an Election Inspector in Michigan, individuals must meet the following age requirements:

- Must be at least 18 `years old by Election Day.
- High School students aged 17 can serve with parental consent.
- Must be a registered voter in Michigan or a student at a Michigan school.
- Training is required before serving on Election Day. One day training and mileage are paid for by the Township. They could also do training online for which it is also paid.
- Must be a U.S. citizen.
- No Felony convictions that would disqualify them from voting.
- Inspectors do not need to live in Wright Township to be an Inspector.

There is a State of Michigan Election Inspector Application attached above, for you to use, or pass along to someone else.
