

Coopersville High Voltage Line Rebuild Project

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

We take pride in providing Michiganders safe and reliable energy service. We are halfway through an ambitious effort to dramatically reduce the frequency and duration of electric outages throughout the state – and customers are seeing a difference.

This work includes a high-voltage (HVD) line rebuild project to improve service in your community during the first quarter of 2023 (Jan-March). This project will require the North Bank Trail to temporarily close. For your safety and ours, please follow posted instructions and do not enter the trail or nearby construction areas. We know this is a popular recreation area for your community and appreciate your support and patience while we complete this work as efficiently as possible.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

This project spans almost 11 miles between Coopersville and Spring Lake. We have started clearing tree branches along the line and removing trees that could create safety risks within the project path. The full project encompasses the area outlined in the map below (68th Ave to the east and 148th Ave to the west).
